# Science4Peace Forum S4P open letter to G7 leaders FARTNER

- Triggered by the ICAN open letter to G7, we also wrote a letter to all G7 leaders:
  - .... We ask you to take the opportunity of the G7 meeting in Hiroshima, to once and forever declare that you personally, and the government of your country, will subscribe to the "no-first use" policy and that your your government will sign the United Nations' Treaty on the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons.
  - ...... The appeal demands from all governments, especially those with nuclear weapons and those in military alliances with them:
  - Urgently declare publicly that you subscribe to the no-first-use policy for nuclear weapons or other weapons of mass destruction, and refrain from any use of these weapons;
  - •Join the Treaty on the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons adopted by the United Nations.



The danger from nuclear weapons is increasing, with nuclear threats, a buildup of nuclear capabilities, deterioration of the multi-decade arms control regime, continuing slow increase in the number of nuclear weapon states (now nine), and new destabilizing technologies such as cyber hacking. Physicists, particularly through collective action, can uniquely influence nuclear weapons policy. While actively engaged prior to the end of the Cold War, physicists' engagement subsequently declined.

## Science4Peace Forum Workshop on Nuclear Weapons at ICTP PARTNER

The workshop focuses on three topics:

- How to inform physicists about nuclear arms issues and engage them in advancing policy change: National organizing efforts, such as visits by experts to physics institutions for presentations and discussion, and local efforts, such as development of courses on nuclear weapons and their control.
- New technical issues affecting nuclear weapons policy: Cyber and anti-satellite threats to nuclear weapon command and control systems, missile defense systems that provoke offensive buildups, climate impacts of nuclear war, and the effects of new sensors and artificial intelligence on strategic stability.
- Physicists as advocates for policy changes: Past successes and failures, how physicists might organize today, potential policy goals, and potential collaboration between physicists across national boundaries.

#### Discussion on Threat of nuclear weapons

- Professor of international politics and nuclear weapons expert Tom Sauer (University of Antwerp) warns that Vladimir Putin is not bluffing when he threatens to use tactical nuclear weapons. (link to translated interview)
- we will invite him for a talk in our S4P meeting on 28. June
- On May 16, 2023, The New York Times published a full-page advertisement signed by 15 U.S. national security experts about the war in Ukraine. It was headed "The U.S. Should Be a Force for Peace in the World," and was drafted by the Eisenhower Media Network. (link to publication, and text)
- Is there a danger for a nuclear escalation or is it just a fear of western scientists and diplomats?
  - · most western politicians think it is a bluff
  - is there any chance to find out (before a full bow off)?

#### Military and Environment



- From my speech at the Wedel Peace demonstration in March 2023
- " .... In addition to all the infinite and immediate suffering for people, the war leads to a massively increased emission of greenhouse gases, such as CO2, by shooting but also by operating war equipment alone: a tank consumes between 250 500 liters of diesel per hour, fighter-jets up to 5000 liters of kerosene per flight hour." ( link to FaktenFinder"die Tagesschau")
- .... However, states do not have to report military emissions. It is estimated that in 2017, the US military emitted more CO2 equivalent than, for example, Sweden, Finland or Denmark as a whole emitted. There are still no figures on how dramatic this is during the war and with the increase in military spending ( link to FaktenFinder"die Tagesschau")."
- Some numbers from Iraq war (link):
  - •The war is responsible for at least 141 million metric tons of carbon dioxide equivalent (MMTCO2e) since March 2003. To put this in perspective, CO2 released by the war to date equals the emissions from putting 25 million more cars on the road in the US this year.

    - donate for some (peace-keeping) projects an amount which would lead to tax reduction of the amount military is financed from your tax
