





Doomsday Clock ticking

The UN chief began by referring to the news that the symbolic Doomsday Clock - developed more than 75 years ago by atomic scientists to measure humanity's proximity to midnight, or self-destruction - was just **90 seconds away** from that hour.

The Russian full-scale invasion of Ukraine, the climate emergency, rising nuclear threats, and the undermining of global norms and institutions have pushed the world closer to annihilation.

"This is the closest the clock has ever stood to humanity's darkest hour – closer than even during the height of the Cold War. In truth, the Doomsday Clock is a global alarm clock. We need to wake up – and get to work," he said.

Appeal: no first – never any use of nuclear weapons

- We have to think our activities in a much larger context:
 - we need to stop any escalation which brings us closer to a nuclear war
 - need to advertise our appeal further:
 - M. Barone suggested to contact Swiss NobelLaureates to urge Swiss Foreign Ministry to bring ban of nuclear weapons on table of security council when Swiss has presidency
 - CERN courier: no reply yet
 - we need to think Science4Peace and Climate crisis together
 - a break of communication channels is a disaster, we need to work together

Stop escalation spiral

· News:

- students from Russia are no longer accepted as summer-students at CERN and DESY
- DESY has launched a particle physics winter school for Ukrainian students (!)
 - only female students were allowed to participate, male students were no allowed to leave the country

CERN LHC experiments decided now on author-ship:

Proposal C:

Authors affiliated with Russian or Belarussian institutes, or with JINR, sign the Collaboration's scientific publications with their names and ORCID identifiers (where available), and the institute affiliation is replaced, respectively, by the reference:

"Affiliated with an institute [or an international laboratory] covered by a cooperation agreement with CERN."

The complete author list including all institute affiliations is made available to the journal in a non-public form for the purpose of machine-readable analysis or as historical data.

No acknowledgement to the Russian and Belarussian funding agencies and JINR is made. On request, the experiment management will release a certificate attesting the contribution of the aforementioned institutes and funding agencies, or of JINR, to the work presented in the publication.

- With the selected option, some authors are singled out discriminatory?
 - it is yet unclear, how Russian and Belorussian Institutes react a danger could be that it is not acceptable, and that they will leave the collaboration
 - it touches the basic principles of CERN on "driver for peace" and international cooperation across borders
 - it touches also principles of good scientific practice
 - it also touches other legal aspects: work which has been performed in the past together will now be published with author list different to that when the work started
- What is it all good for ?
 - does it help to stop the war?
 - does it help the people in Ukraine (a friend from Ukraine was asking this)

- A. Gritsan (CMS, J. Hopkins Univ) has a very strict point of view (in a letter to CERN DG)
 - The decisions made on the basis of beliefs, nationality, culture, ethnicity, race, among others, violate the fundamental principles set in the CERN Code of Conduct. Yet, two of the three options put to vote have a built-in bias based solely on nationality of the Institutions or Funding Agencies involved, not based on achievements or conduct of any of the individual Institutions. No explanation or justification is given to these options in the Procedures. These options would enforce removal of Institute affiliations and/or Funding Agencies of the authors only from the Russian or Belarussian institutes, or JINR, and would violate the above fundamental principles.
 - Many collaborators of the four experiments are members of the American, European, and other Physical Societies (APS, EPS, and others). Scientific journals published by these Societies are among the main venues for publications of the four experiments. Ethics Guidelines of these Societies demand fair treatment of colleagues and subordinates. Let us quote APS Ethics Guidelines: "The APS specifically rejects discrimination based upon race, color, national origin, sex, religion, disability, age, gender identity, sexual orientation, and political ideology." An explicit bias based on national origin is introduced in the Procedures, as explained in point (3). This will create an obstacle in publishing journal papers and will violate ethics standards of the Society members.
