The status of disarmament negotiations in the current international contest will be presented by the speaker, who already made a presentation at the Forum in November 2023. He will be available to interact with the participants after his talk.

Some of the main topics treated in the presentation, and possibly discussed with the participants, are:

- has the risk of a nuclear weapon use increased recently, as a consequence of the deterioration of the international situation?
- how can we move out of the current impasse and the current situation?
- how can we escape the general trend of militarization also in science ?
- how to deal with increased dual-use classification in science?

Discussion will be under Chatham House rule: participants are free to use the information received, but neither the identity nor the affiliation of the speaker(s), nor that of any other participant, may be revealed.

Ambassador L. Bencini is the Permanent Representative of Italy to the UN Conference on Disarmament; he served as President of the Conference in the session January–February 2025. Previously, he has served in Rome, Rio de Janeiro, Oslo, Moscow, St. Petersburg and now Geneva. He has dealt with United Nations issues at various stages of his career - from human rights to peacekeeping and peacebuilding, from UN reform to sustainable development.

Abstract: Die Sicherheitslage in Europa hat sich dramatisch verändert - vor allem infolge des Ukrainekriegs, der Feindschaft zwischen Russland und fast allen anderen Ländern des Kontinents, der Kehrtwende der US-Administration bezüglich der Unterstützung der Ukraine sowie des Bruchs mit den europäischen NATO-Verbündeten und Kanada. Die Schlussfolgerung, die daraus in Europa gezogen wird, ist vor allem eine: Aufrüstung und selbst ein geopolitischer Player werden. Der Vortrag versucht folgende Fragen zu beantworten: Wieviel Militär und wieviel Rüstung brauchen wir, um Sicherheit vor äußerer Bedrohung zu gewährleisten? Wenn Aufrüstung noch lange keine Sicherheits- und Friedensstrategie ist: Worin besteht eine erfolgreiche Sicherheits- und Verteidigungspolitik? Was bedeutet ein „geopolitisches Europa“? Und was sind eigentlich die Ursachen für Kriege und gewaltsame Konflikte in und um Europa, die in den letzten Jahrzehnten zugenommen haben, obwohl seit einem Vierteljahrhundert die militärischen Ausgaben kontinuierlich ansteigen und die NATO wenigstens bis vor kurzem in der Eigenwahrnehmung, wie 2024 zum 75. Jubiläum gefeiert, „das stärkste und erfolgreichste Militärbündnis der Geschichte“ war?

Dual Use issues



- How to deal with Dual-Use ?
 - we cannot escape – even publication dopes not safe us !
 - examples:
 - AI identification – face recognition
 - Pattern recognition in particle physics
 - Radiation hard electronic in particle physics
 - etc ..
 - need to carefully evaluate risks and advantages of research
 - needs to be public
 - requires responsibility of science institutions and individual scientists
 - etc

Dual Use



- How to deal with Dual-Use – points for discussion !
 - responsibility of science and scientists:
 - need a permanent process of investigation and evaluation of risks
 - Seminars on responsibility of scientist !
 - Technical and scientific consequences assessment
 - Dual-Use research needs to be complemented with peace-building measures: support of special programs, dedicated studies, etc
 - Commitment to responsibility !
 - Civil Clauses helps individual scientists to take responsibility !
 - etc !
