 - ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE AND NUCLEAR WAR RISK

Karl-Hans Bläsius (Unv Trier, Germany)

Abstract: Ever shorter warning times in early warning systems for nuclear threats require increasing use of AI techniques. However, due to the uncertain and incomplete data basis, even AI systems cannot reliably assess threat situations. The risks will continue to increase. This is because an arms race based on the current situation will also occur in connection with AI in particular. This could give rise to weapons systems in the next few years that will be uncontrollable by humans. On May 30, leading AI scientists and AI company executives warned that AI could lead to the extinction of humanity. Developments of specialized non-military AI applications could spiral out of control and dominate the flow of information on the Internet. As a result, social systems could become unstable. This would also significantly increase the risk of nuclear war.

- Decides to proclaim the period 2024–2033 the International Decade of Sciences for Sustainable Development, within existing structures and available resources, to represent a unique opportunity for humanity to use the critical role that sciences play in the pursuit of sustainable development in its three dimensions as one of the key means of implementation as well as in responding to the complex challenges of our time to ensure a safe and prosperous future for all;
- Invites the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization to lead the
 implementation of the Decade, in collaboration with other relevant organizations of the United
 Nations system as well as other stakeholders, including those involved in the International
 Year of Basic Sciences for Sustainable Development, identifying and developing activities and
 programmes within their mandates and using existing resources and voluntary contributions,
 as appropriate;

 - Remote Summer-schools: based on the experience of this years summer-school hosted by DESY, we could prepare and propose remote summer-schools together with CERN to especially invite students from countries who have little chances to participate in regular schools
 - low threshold entry
 - no costs
 - provide physics training on relevant and up-to-date projects which can be worked on from remote
 - Towards sustainability in computing: a project to overcome the oldest sanctions against a country – a computing center for the Caribbean fully on renewable energies hosted in Cuba.
 - involves renewable energy supply
 - developments in computing center operation
 - developments in efficient computing algorithms physics applications
