

Timeline Schengen case (1)

- Flagging discovered in May 2018 after application for visa to IT
- 3 August 2018: IT lawyer addressed the IT ministry of interior to access the content of SIS (Schengen Information System)
- 30 August 2018: answer from the IT M.I.: the request was forwarded to the FR M.I. Without answer. Suggested to contact the FR CNIL (National Commission on Informatics and Liberty)

Timeline Schengen case (2)

- 17 October 2018: CNIL is contacted with the request of getting access to the SIS content
- 26 October 2018: CNIL answered = this is within the competence of FR M.I., requested forwarded.
- 3 December 2018: FR M.I. requested to renew the demand by postal email
- 12 December 2018: registered email sent to FR M.I., acknowledged on 17 December 2018

Timeline Schengen case (3)

- 13 March 2019: new visa request rejected, this time with both FR and CH mentioned as the flagging countries
- 15 March 2019: due to absence of reaction from FR M.I., mail to CNIL
- 20 March 2019: CNIL answer => a member of commission will do the appropriate check
- No further news, several relaunches:
 - 23 April 2019. answer: “verification ungoing”
 - 21 May 2019. No answer
- 1 July 2019: CNIL president answer: cannot provide more information due to opposition from FR M.I. a) to the access b) to any request of suppression or rectification

Timeline Schengen case (4)

- 4 September 2019: opening of a file at the Paris Admin. Court
- No reaction of the FR M.I. to the memo
- 22 December 2020: the court ordered the FR M.I. to produce a memo within a month but without the content being disclosed to us
- 8 February 2021: FR M.I. Provided undisclosed (to the plaintiff) elements to the court
- 23 April 2021: the court canceled the decision of FR M.I. of not recognizing elements with the request of disclosing info of national SIS (N-SIS II) within a month
 - This was not respected (again)

Timeline Schengen case (5)

- 3 August 2021: request to Paris court to enforce the execution of the April 2021 judgement
- 15 December 2021: after several relaunches, the FR M.I. Finally recognizing the flagging in SIS II
- 16 February 2022: request to the court to cancel the flagging
- 10 Mai 2022: Paris court decides that the request is from the competence of the court of Cergy Pontoise...

Timeline Schengen case (6)

- During the full instruction of the case at Cergy Pointoise court, the FR M.I. Produced no memo
- Until.... 8 January 2025: the FR M.I. asks for the rejection of the request (cancel the flagging)
- 5 Mai 2025: the request is rejected by Cergy Pontoise court...
- July 2025: appeal at the Paris court of Appeal
- September 2025: the court of appeal ordered the FR M.I. to produce an answer to the appeal memo within two months
 - **The order was not executed to this day**
